The bike brand of cycling distributor Moore Large has produced a very decent package with its Victeur bike. With a long top-tube and

stem and classic shape bar, the setup is spot on for aspiring racers, one of our testers reckoning it handled like the racy Cannondale SuperSix. The Truvativ chainset, 105 shifters and Tektro brakes also form a strong component combo. The wheels are a little more flexible than we'd like, though this does contribute to comfortable seated riding. Overall it's a good-looking machine, but it's up against some serious opposition from the likes of Cube and Rose, among others.
