

Knog Boomer USB, Front £33.99, Back £31.99

According to Australian bike buffs Knog, USB stands for 'U Son of a Bitch' and is the cry from many of us when we discover our bike-light batteries need replacing. Again. So Knog invented the Boomer USB. It's a waterproof, self-contained unit that you recharge by simply plugging it into any USB port. There are four lights modes (constant, strobe, fast flash and random) and an indicator to show when the batteries are low. It takes two to four hours to recharge and delivers four hours of light in constant mode and 36 hours in strobe mode. The front light produces an impressive 55 lumens and the rear 30 lumens. It's available in six cool colours.
