The USP of the Limar is that it's the world's lightest helmet and on the kitchen scales our medium sample came in at 170g. Ultra lightweight often comes with a price, though, and with the Limar this price is comfort. The removable padding is extremely sparse and the cradle, although having a user-friendly adjustment dial, is minimal to the point of being ineffective. We were unable to get a comfy fit, and even smaller headed riders who tried it complained of a perched-on-top-

of-head feeling. The airflow through the 22 vents is probably the best on test but your head just doesn't feel as enveloped by it as other helmets. On the plus side, the anti-insect mesh over the intake vents is a feature we'd like to see on more helmets, as a wasp in the helmet is no fun at all.

VERDICT

Ultra light but definitely not designed for a long training ride
