The metallic trim and buttons of the PC 25.10 give a really classy, solid look and feel. And although it may be bulky for the more dainty wristed, overall it scores well on aesthetics. Function wise it does everything you'd want from a basic monitor and, most importantly, you can manually set a zone and get the crucial 'time in zone' data post workout. Memory space for just one workout is pretty limited, though, even for a low-end monitor. And the chest strap is a bit on the clunky side compared to some of the soft comfort straps now available, but out running, was unobtrusive and didn't rub. The supplied bike mount is a thoughtful touch and something you'd often pay extra for. As you'd expect from German engineering, syncing is spot on and there were no signal problems throughout the test. **NC**

A decent basic monitor but we'd still expect more memory for the price.
